

Get a Graduate

As we all know graduates are finding jobs hard to come by and the Government is supporting a number of schemes to help them get a start. One scheme is run by the University of Chichester.

Options:

- Take on an intern for 12 weeks full time, until October you can get a subsidy of £750 to support this.
- Take on an intern for 2 days per week for 12 weeks 180 hours in total get a subsidy of £250
- Collaborate with other HHDBA members so that between them they can offer five days a week for 12 weeks – one employer must take the intern on as an employee billing the others for their share of the costs. This would also attract the £750 subsidy. So say three members might work together, two firms offering two days per week and the other one.

The only commitment would be to pay the graduate the national minimum wage in all three models.
